DESCRIPTION	<p>The Red Bull Air Race is an exciting competition in which the world's most talented pilots are up against each other in a race based on speed, precision and skill.</p> <p>The competition features a dynamic new discipline of flying, called 'air racing' where the objective is to navigate a challenging race course in the sky, in the fastest possible time. Flying individually against the clock, the pilots have to execute tight turns through a slalom course consisting of specially designed pylons, known as 'Air Gates'. In the interest of ensuring broad participation across the pay grades, each team is allowed a maximum of 21 Pay Grade Points, that is, the sum of the pay grades of all four players per foursome cannot exceed 21.

The tournament is conducted on the Navy's Admiral Baker North and South Courses, and concludes in the evening with an Awards Dinner for all participants, sponsors, and volunteers.
